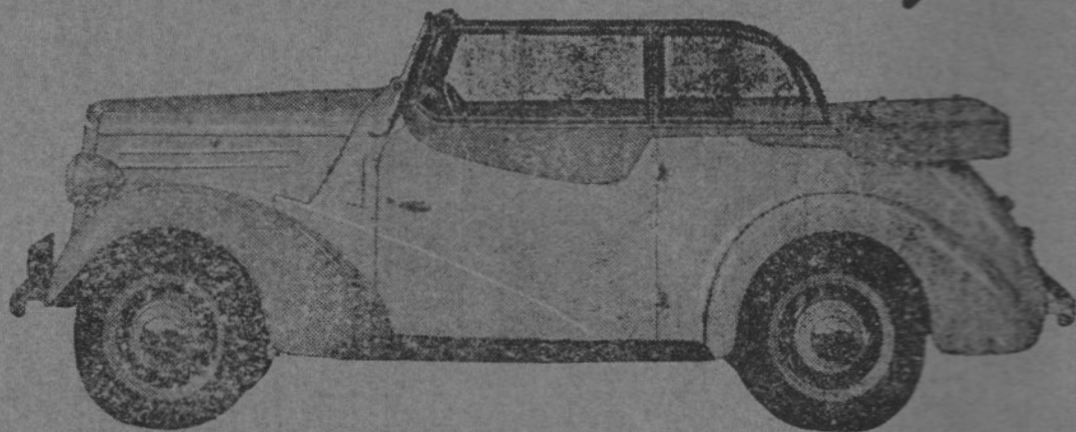

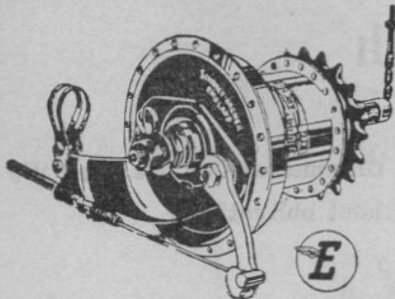

## *West Australia's Cycling Classic*

### THE BEVERLEY TO PERTH ROAD RACE

Not the value of the prize to be won  
But the glory of a race well run.

In all spheres of sport, there is one event which through each season is recognised as its classic trial of skill and stamina, and success in such an event hall marks the athlete to the calendar of previous winners and to be remembered by champions of the future

And so with the Beverley to Perth Road Race. Founded in 1897 by the late Mr. P. W. Armstrong it has become an annual event except during the war periods 1914-1919 and 1942-1945. Until 1936, the original course via Balup and Red Hill was followed, but from 1937-1946 the course has been via Bakers Hill, Sawyers Valley and Greenmount. This year the race is to be decided over the old course, to which many alterations and improvements have been made, most noticeable at Devil's Elbow and the Gidgies. At the former it is now a graduated curve and at the Gidgies the treacherous loose gravel has disappeared. But just the same the long arduous climbs are still there sufficient to test the stamina of the riders.

For many years it was the ambition of many great riders to complete the course under six hours, but it was not till 1911 that A. Kaiser made the time 5hrs. 58mins. 33secs. This time stood till 1925 when W. E. Marshall reduced it to 5hrs. 42mins. 25secs. In 1929 Horrie Marshall further reduced it to 5hrs. 21mins. 14secs. In 1935 Dean Toseland—the famous South Australian rider—covered the distance in 5hrs. 15mins. 38secs. This record still stands.

F. Jones: Winner and fastest 1927 and fastest time 1930 and 1931.

A. Schulze: Fastest time 1920, 1921, 1922.

W. Bonser: Winner and fastest 1940 and fastest 1941.

W. Pender: Winner 1929, fastest 1933.

H. Marshall: Fastest 1928 and 1929.

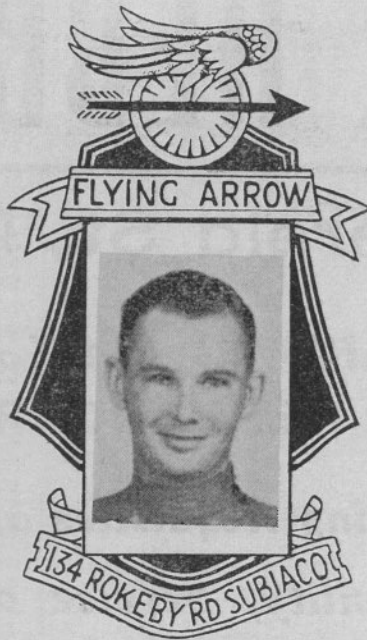
