IMPORTANT NOTICE

FRIENDS of competitors following the race are requested to note that one of the rules of the race reads that a car must not be nearer than 200 yards to a rider. Stewards will report to the referee any rider who receives encouragement from a car nearer than this distance, and it is in the referee's power to disqualify that rider immediately. Don't jeopardise the chances of a rider—KEEP WELL OUT of the WAY, and there will then be no arguments.

Competitors and enthusiasts should also note that riders may not receive any outside assistance in any shape or form. Riders must carry their own Drinks and Food, and may replenish only at the Official Feed Stations at Northam and Balup. Notices reading "Official Feed Station" will be displayed at these places.
