Rules of Competition:

1. Riders changing machines for any reason will be disqualified.
2. In the event of punctures, wheels may be changed, but without outside assistance in fitting or inflating tyres.
3. No feeding is permitted beyond Gidgegannup.

Instructions for following Vehicles:

1. Any vehicle following a rider, must pull away from the convoy if and when that rider abandons the contest.
2. All vehicles in convoy must leave at least three car lengths between the riders or the vehicle ahead to minimize inconvenience to other road users.
3. No vehicle will be permitted to attend riders beyond the top of Red Hill. Such vehicles will be required to move past the field and on to the finish.
