Set Up/Pack Down

6am onwards Wednesday 9th November 2022 with unloading completed by 8am at this point vehicles must be off the grounds by 8.30am. **There is to be no vehicle movement on the grounds between 8.30am and 3.00pm for safety reasons** except for emergency vehicles. If possible, please bring a trolley, park in the Site Holders Parking and transport your materials through to your marquee to minimise the number of cars accessing the front of marquees. If you wish to set up Tuesday afternoon, please contact SRCWA on 9492 9772.

Have a Go Day, a LiveLighter Event operates from 9.00am – 3.00pm, site holders are reminded as part of the terms and conditions of their application they agree to be on site for the full event.

NOTE: whilst unloading your vehicle, please park as close to the entrance of your marquee to avoid obstructing passing vehicles, once you have unloaded your site resources, **please move your vehicle before setting up your site**, this will help with traffic management on the day.

Parking

Site holder parking is at the end of the event. Once vehicles are parked in this area they **cannot be moved before 3.00pm**. If you plan to move your vehicle throughout the day, please park in Crown Public Carparks.

We have included a coloured piece of paper with your site and entry gate number on it, the colour of the paper corresponds with the colour of the area where your site is situated. Please show this coloured paper to the Traffic Marshall as you arrive on the day, this will assist in getting everyone to their sites as efficiently as possible and avoid any undue traffic delay.

Site Requirements

On the day in an effort to assist the volunteers with the end of day clean up, please ensure your site is left tidy i.e.: rubbish to be placed in bins and boxes to be broken down placed in bins or taken away. **Failure to do this will result in your organisation being charged a \$150.00 Site Clean-up fee.**

If you have requested power, please ensure you bring sufficient **extension cords minimum 25m**.
